

Meditations on the Stations of the Cross

St. John Henry Newman

1801 – 1890



At the beginning of each Station:

Leader: We adore you, O Christ and we praise you.

All: For by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

After each Station:

The Lord's Prayer and 1 Hail Mary

Welcome (*Angela Stramaglia, Sheil Catholic Center at Northwestern University – Director of Music & Liturgy*)

- 1 Opening Prayer* and First Station – Jesus is condemned to death**
- 2 Second Station – Jesus receives His Cross**
- 3 Third Station – Jesus falls for the first time**
- 4 Fourth Station – Jesus meets His Mother**
- 5 Fifth Station – Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus to carry the Cross**
- 6 Sixth Station – Jesus and Veronica**
- 7 Seventh Station – Jesus falls a second time**
- 8 Eighth Station – Jesus comforts the Women of Jerusalem**
- 9 Ninth Station – Again, a third time, Jesus falls**
- 10 Tenth Station – Jesus is stripped of His garments**
- 11 Eleventh Station – Jesus is nailed to the Cross***
- 12 Twelfth Station – Jesus dies upon the Cross**
- 13 Thirteenth Station – Jesus is Taken Down from the Cross**
- 14 Fourteenth Station – Jesus is Laid in the Tomb**
